- CBT 1
- CBT 2
- CBAT (Aptitude Test)
- Document Verification
- Medical Test

## 4) RRB JE Selection

- CBT 1
- CBT 2
- Document Verification
- Medical Test

# Railway Exam Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility depends on the exam.

## Educational Qualification

### RRB NTPC

- 12th pass for some posts
- Graduation for graduate-level posts

## **RRB Group D**

- 10th pass OR ITI OR equivalent

## **RRB ALP**

- 10th + ITI (relevant trade)  
OR
- Diploma in Engineering

## **RRB Technician**

- 10th + ITI / Diploma (as per post)

## **RRB JE**

- Diploma / Degree in Engineering

## **Age Limit (General)**

### **RRB NTPC**

- 18 to 30 years (*varies by post*)

### **RRB Group D**

- 18 to 33 years (*as per latest updates*)

### **RRB ALP**

- 18 to 30 years

### **RRB JE**

- 18 to 33 years

*(Age relaxation applies as per government rules.)*

# **Physical Efficiency Test (PET) – Group D**

Candidates must qualify PET:

**Male**

- Lift and carry 35 kg for 100 meters in 2 minutes
- Run 1000 meters in 4 minutes 15 seconds

### **Female**

- Lift and carry 20 kg for 100 meters in 2 minutes
- Run 1000 meters in 5 minutes 40 seconds

*(Standards may vary slightly as per notification.)*
