

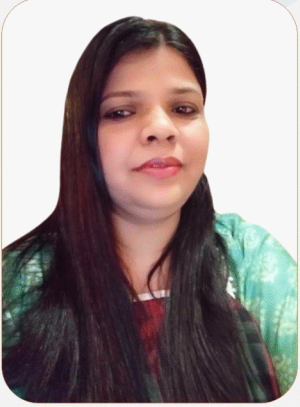

Current Affairs Related to 21st February

- ◆ **US semiconductor equipment maker Lam Research has announced to invest** over 10000 crores in Karnataka. This announcement was made at the Global Investors Meet held at Bengaluru Palace: Investment 2025. The move is in line with the government's goal to strengthen India's semiconductor ecosystem and promote domestic chip manufacturing. Lam Arc has signed an agreement with the board of Inquilab Industries Limited, following which the company will share land in Bangalore under Whitefield and will be included in the procurement.
- ◆ **Pakistan's star batsman Babar Azam has once again registered a historic** achievement in his name. He made a record of becoming the fastest player to complete 6000 runs in international. Babar played this feat during the tri-series against New Zealand at the National Stadium. Babar Azam achieved this milestone in just 123 innings, joining the record of South African veteran batsman Hashim Amla.
- ◆ **The Haryana government has implemented new naming rules that recommend** killing the male of the Nilgai. This decision has been taken to reduce human wildlife conflict and prevent damage to agriculture by Nilgais. However, this decision has been opposed by many scholars, including environmental scientists and the Bishnoi community, as they consider the Nilgai sacred. Critics say that hunting is neither ethical, nor a permanent solution.
- ◆ **India's largest energy producer NTPC Ltd has been awarded the Forward** Faster Sustainability Award 2025 by the United Nations Global Compact Network India.
- ◆ **Cristiano Ronaldo has once again topped the list of the highest-paid athletes** of 2025, the report revealed. According to the report, the football star has earned \$285 million, including an annual income of \$200 million from his Saudi Arabian club Al Nassr and an additional \$65 million from his endorsements and commercial companies. His financial success is offset by the growing commercial value of football and the increasing investment in the sport by Middle Eastern clubs.
- ◆ **The Chartered Institute of India has announced the** appointment of C.I. Charanjot Singh Nanda as its 73rd President and C.A. Khush Kumar D as Vice President. Their election will be for 2025-2026 and this leadership will be impressive. The ICAI, which regulates auditoriums in India, has entrusted both experienced professionals with the responsibility of maintaining high professional standards.
- ◆ **Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi met SpaceX CEO Elon Musk at Blair House** in Washington DC. During the meeting, Musk gifted PM Modi a hexagonal engineering heatshield tile, which was used on SpaceX's Starship Test Flight 5 in October 2024. Modi also gifted Indian classical music to children as part of the investigation into the gift.
- ◆ **The Reserve Bank of India has given Julia Investments a 7% hike in** AU Small Finance Bank. Julia Investments is a subsidiary of Temasek Holdings, and the investment is involved in India's financial sector. Jaipur-based AU Small Finance Bank is India's largest small finance bank that provides financial strength to micro, small and medium enterprises.
- ◆ **Swedish defence company Saab has signed a Memorandum of Understanding** with Hindustan Aeronautics Limited for cooperation in manufacturing of Electronic Warfare Laser Warning System 310. The agreement is aimed at strengthening India's defence sector and ensuring domestic manufacturing of this advanced laser warning system as the first step under Make in India. The main objective of this LWS is to set up a server for production and training of 310 system.
