Current Affairs Related to 24th February

- The first Regional Dialogue on Social Justice will be held on 24-25 February 2025 at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. The Ministry of Labour and Employment will host it in collaboration with the Confederation of Indian Industry and the Indian Employers Association. India is leading the first regional dialogue under the Global Alliance for Social Justice. More than 80 alliance partners from the Asia Pacific region will come together as part of this dialogue. ILO Director-General Gilbert F. Houngbo will be the keynote speaker. The first regional dialogue on social justice will also mark the 74th Foundation Day of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation.
- The AI program has been launched by the Center to empower one lakh young inventors. The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship National Skill Development Corporation and Intel India have launched AI Micro Learning Modules for Entrepreneurship. The program aims to encourage entrepreneurial thinking among young Indian entrepreneurs and clarify AI concepts. By 2025, it aims to equip one lakh youth with the skills required for a technologically advanced economy.
- ◆ President Draupadi Murmu has appointed Election Commissioner Gyanesh Kumar as the new Chief Election Commissioner. His tenure will be till 26 January 2029. He is the 26th Chief Election Commissioner of India. CEC Gyanesh Kumar is a former IAS officer. He is a 1998 batch officer of Kerala cadre. He was on the post of Secretary in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs.
- Odisha Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi has presented a state budget of Rs 2.90 lakh crore for the financial year 2025-2026. The budget focuses on agriculture and irrigation. Rs 37,838 crore has been allocated for agriculture and allied sectors. This is an increase of about 12 percent compared to last year's budget. About 48% of Odisha's workforce depends on agriculture. 80% people live in rural areas.
- Mutual Credit Guarantee Scheme for MSMEs was launched by the Center, as announced in the Union Budget 2025-2026 to promote micro, small and medium enterprises. Under this scheme, MSMEs are provided collateral free loans up to Rs 100 crore for purchasing plant machinery or equipment.

- The government approved the continuation of PM ASHA scheme till 2025-2026. The objective of the integrated PM ASHA scheme is the effective implementation of procurement work. The government has allowed the purchase of tur, urad and lentils under the price support scheme. In Budget 2025, the government has also announced that the purchase of tur, urad, and lentils up to 100 percent of the state's production will be continued for the next four years.
- French President Emmanuel Macron will host the emergency European summit on Ukraine. Leaders of several European countries, including the Prime Minister of Britain, will attend the emergency summit on the Ukraine war. German Chancellor Olaf Scholz, Polish Prime Minister Donald Tusk, NATO Secretary General Mark Rutte, Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni and Ursula von der Leyen and Antonio Costa from the European Union will attend the summit.
- ♦ Under the Deep Ocean Mission initiative, the Ministry of Earth Sciences has tasked the National Institute of Ocean Technology to develop Matsya 6000, a fourth-generation deep-sea submersible under the Samudrayaan project. The trials are a significant step towards conducting shallow water trials up to a depth of 500 metres by the end of 2025. The state-of-the-art submersible with a diameter of 2.1 metres is designed for three-person operation. Matsya 6000 is a significant milestone in the country's ocean exploration capability.
 - In a major technological breakthrough, India has developed the world's largest 10-tonne propellant mixer for solid rocket motors. ISRO's Satish Dhawan Space Centre has designed the mixer in collaboration with the Central Manufacturing Technology Institute in Bengaluru. The mixer weighs 150 tonnes and has a height of 8.7 m, length of 5.4 m and width of 3.3 m. It ensures accurate and safe mixing of the solid propellant material required for the rocket launch.
- Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Shivraj Singh Chouhan inaugurated the National Geospatial Knowledge Based Land Survey Pilot Programme of Urban Settlements. It will be launched in 152 urban local bodies of 26 states and 3 Union Territories in Raisen, Madhya Pradesh. The map programme will be implemented by the Department of Land Resources under the Ministry of Rural Development.
