### **Current Affairs Related to 26th February**

- The Ministry of Defence signed a contract worth over 1220 crores with Bharat Electronics Limited in New Delhi for the procurement of 149 software defined radios for the Indian Coast Guard. These state-of-the-art radios will enable secure and reliable information sharing, collaboration and contextual awareness through high-speed data and secure voice communications. This will strengthen the ability of the Indian Coast Guard to perform its core responsibilities including maritime law enforcement, search and rescue operations, fisheries protection and marine environmental protection.
- ♠ India is the second country in the world to launch a digital pilot license. Union Civil Aviation Minister Ram Mohan Naidu has launched the Electronic Personnel License of India. The Electronic Personnel License will replace the traditional physical license. The Electronic Personnel License can be accessed through the EasyCA mobile application. The initiative aims to increase security, transparency and efficiency in the process of pilot licensing. Due to the Electronic Personnel License initiative, global employment for pilots will improve.
- The government extended the tenure of CEA Anant Nageswaran till March 2027. Mr Nageswaran's tenure was approved by the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet, headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, on contract basis till March 31, 2027. Mr Nageswaran took over as CEA for a three-year term on January 28, 2022, replacing Krishnamurthy Subramaniam, who had served in the post for three years.
- ♦ Gujarat Finance Minister Kanubhai Desai presented a Rs 3.70 trillion budget for the fiscal year 2025-2026. The budget outlay of Rs 3,70,250 crore for 2025-2026 represents a growth of Rs 37,785 crore or 11.3 per cent. The state government proposed a tax relief of Rs 148 crore in the form of reduction in stamp duty on mortgage deeds and motor vehicle tax on electric vehicles. A Developed Gujarat Fund has been proposed with a corpus of Rs 50,000 crore.
- India and Malaysia have finalised a crucial defence cooperation group to strengthen their portfolio of Russian-origin Sukhoi-30s.

- Rajasthan Deputy Chief Minister Diya Kumari presented the state budget for 2025-2026. The budget focuses on job creation, increasing water supply and infrastructure development. The state government aims to make Rajasthan a 350 billion economy by 2030. Rajasthan's GDP is expected to exceed Rs 19.89 lakh crore in 2025-2026. Under this budget, the government announced 5 lakh new domestic electricity connections and 5000 electricity connections exclusively for agricultural use.
- Ajmer hosted the first All India Conference of Transgenders. Anita Bai has been the guru of Saloni Nayak, the Gaddipati of Ajmer's transgender community. About 2,000 members of the community participated in the Panch Anushthan performed in the Khichdi Tulai festival. The community collectively performs the Khichdi Tulai ritual, which is the first ritual of the conference.
- ◆ TRIFED partners with Meesho, IFCA and MGIRI. In a significant step towards promoting the economic prosperity of the community, TRIFED has partnered with Meesho Indian Culinary Association and Mahatma Gandhi Institute for Rural Industrialization. The collaboration has worked to develop adolescents in the 2BB sector and ensure their market expansion.
  - Life Insurance Corporation of India has launched a new digital initiative called One Main Office to enhance its associate professor. Its primary objective is to realize the ideal vision of insurance for all by 2047. It provides the starting company an easy way to sales, customer service and business management by 24x7 digital business. LIC, India's largest insurance company, is investing heavily in digital transformation and One Main Office is an important step in this direction.
  - The 9th Asia Economic Dialogue was held in Pune, Maharashtra. Union Minister Piyush Goyal addressed the 9th Asia Economic Dialogue. The theme of this dialogue was economic resilience and revival in the era of fragmentation. Many key contemporary topics of geo-economics were discussed in the meeting, including artificial intelligence and automation, economic imperatives of cyber security, etc.
