Current Affairs Related to 1st March 2025

- Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan said that a national committee will soon be formed to promote natural farming. He emphasized on adopting natural farming. Under this, a committee will be formed at the national level to make this mission a movement. This committee will work towards increasing awareness among farmers and training them to adopt natural farming methods. Chouhan said that natural farming will increase the income of farmers, maintain the fertility of the soil and provide chemical-free food to the citizens.
- The Uttarakhand government has presented a budget of Rs 1,01,175.33 crore under the leadership of Chief Minister Pulwama Singh Dhami for the financial year 2025-2026. The main objective of this budget presented in the state assembly by Finance Minister Prem Chandra Aggarwal is to promote financial, public welfare and economic development, as well as ensure financial stability.
- The Times Higher Education World Reputation Rankings 2025 works on prestigious studios around the world, which includes excellence and global recognition. This year also, Harvard University has topped the list for the 14th consecutive year, while Oxford University and Institute of Technology have jointly secured second place. This year four major institutions of India have been included in this list, but the ranking of all has declined.
- Asia's first Global Hyperloop Competition 2025 has been organized by IIT Madras. 150 industry representatives from all over the world participated in this program. The competition was held at Discovery, Satellite Campus of Indian Institute of Technology Madras, Thaiyur. The competition was organized by IIT Madras, IITM Pravartak Technologies Foundation and SAE India with additional support from the Ministry of Railways and the Government of India.
- Barite, feldspar, mica and quartz have been removed from the list of minor minerals and put in the category of major minerals. Quartz, feldspar and mica are found in pegmatite rocks, which are important sources of many important minerals. These minerals are important for new technologies in the mainland-to-energy transition, the space industry, the healthcare sector, etc.

- India is on its way to becoming a high-income nation by 2047, with its GDP expected to grow from \$23 trillion to \$35 trillion. According to a report by Bain & Company and NASSCOM, the services sector and manufacturing sectors will play the most important role in India's economic growth. Technology, workforce expansion and land-use investments in key sectors will be key to driving this transformation. India's workforce is expected to grow to 200 million in the next two decades, driving job creation and economic expansion.
- Bisleri International has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Scientific Survey of India under the Adopt a Heritage 2.0 programme. The combined objective of the initiative is to promote the restoration and conservation of the water empire at India's historic sites. This first Bisleri CSR programme is part of Nayi Umeed, which combines water conservation and mineral conservation.
- Industrial policies of Madhya Pradesh were launched by Prime Minister Modi at the Global Investors Summit. Hundreds of guests from across the world were hosted in the newly built tent city near Kaliyasot Dam in the capital of Madhya Pradesh. The Prime Minister addressed investors, industrialists, NRIs and startups from India and abroad and launched the industrial policies of Madhya Pradesh. It also included international sessions like Global South Country Conference, Latin America and Caribbean Session and special sessions for key partner countries.
- PM Modi nominated 10 prominent personalities to help tackle obesity. These personalities include Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah, businessman Anand Mahindra and actor Mohanlal. Other nominated personalities include Bhojpuri singer-actor Nirahua, shooting champion Manu Bhaker, weightlifter Mirabai Chanu, Infosys cofounder Nandan Nilekani, actor R Madhavan, singer Shreya Ghoshal and philanthropist Sudha Murthy.
- ♦ Bank credit to non-banking financial companies in India to fall to 6.7% in 2024. Bank credit to NBFCs reached Rs 16.22 lakh crore by December. Bank credit to NBFCs grew at a rate of 15% in 2023. This decline was due to higher financing costs after the RBI increased the risk weight on such loans.


