Current Affairs Related to 11th March

- ◆ Under the leadership of Uttarakhand Chief Minister Yuvraj Singh Dhami, important decisions have been taken related to governance reform, simplification of pension facilities and restructuring of the new educational policy. These judges promote the prosperity of the government towards the economic growth, public welfare and cultural preservation of the state. Uttarakhand has approved a valid pension scheme for state officials and employees under the National Pension System, which will give them a stable and assured pension after retirement.
- India launched the Urban Development Alliance for Cities, an important step towards sustainable urban development. This multinational alliance seeks to promote knowledge sharing and private sector participation among cities to develop sustainable support solutions for waste management and resources. It is the first India-shaped Pro Planet People ideology. In which 3R principle and class economy have been promoted. Promoting urban sustainability and promoting collaboration between cities policy makers, industry and development enterprises.
- ◆ India has taken an important step towards world peace and unity, under which the country's first Vishwa Shanti Kendra has been inaugurated in Gurgaon, Haryana. This center has been established by Ahimsa Vishwa Bharti Jain Acharya and aims to promote non-violence, spiritual awareness, humanism and global brotherhood.
- ◆ President of India Smt. Draupadi Murmu inaugurated the second edition of Amrit Mahotsav of Diversity at Rashtrapati Bhavan. This festival depicts the rich cultural heritage of India, with each edition showing a glimpse of different colors. This time the event is focused on the states of South India, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Central Use Lakshadweep and Puducherry. It provides an opportunity to the beginning artists, partners and culinary experts to portray their hunger.
- The Central Government has appointed Ajay Bhadu, Additional Secretary in the Department of Commerce, as the Chief Executive Officer of the registered e-marketplace. This step has been taken by Tata Consultancy to transform the e-marketplace into a new generation digital marketplace. Ajay Bhadu, a 1999 batch Gujarat cadre officer, has extensive experience in governance, urban infrastructure development and policy implementation.

- The Cabinet has approved the amendment of the Livestock Health and Disease Control Program. The scheme has three components, National Animal Disease Control Program, Livestock Health and Disease Control and Animal Medicine. Animal medicine has been added as a new component in the LHDCP scheme. The implementation of LHDCP will reduce these losses by preventing diseases through vaccination.
- Union Minister Bhupendra Yadav inaugurated the World Sustainable Development Summit 2025 in New Delhi. Several dignitaries including Guyana Prime Minister Brigadier Mark Philip and Brazil's Environment and Climate Change Minister Marina Silva attended the inaugural summit ceremony. The theme of the summit is Partnerships to Accelerate Sustainable Development and Climate Solutions. It has been organized by The Energy and Resources Institute.
- The Defence and Development Organisation has successfully conducted high-level testing of indigenous life support system for indigenous fighter aircraft Tejas. This ILSS based on on-board oxygen generating system replaces the requirement of conventional liquid oxygen generating system and generates oxygen for oxygen generating system during flight. The tests were conducted by Defence Bio Engineering and Electro Medical Laboratory, Bengaluru.
- The Supreme Court of India ruled that the right against disability-based discrimination should be considered as a fundamental right. This decision approves the standards of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 and the participation of people involved in democratic service recruitment. A bench of Justices B Pardiwala and R Mahadevan gave this decision during petitions related to Madhya Pradesh Kashmir Service Test Rules, 1994 and Rajasthan Kashmir Service Test Rules 2010.
- China's Liu Jiakun was awarded the Pritzker Prize, also known as the Nobel of architecture. Liu Jiakun has spent most of his career designing academic buildings, museums and public spaces. His architecture aims to create a beautiful, just, and respectful livable environment. Liu's firm, Jiakun Architects, has completed over 30 projects in China.


