Current Affairs Related to 12th March

- Zerodha founder and CEO Nithin Kamath has been awarded the EY Entrepreneur of the Year Award 2024. Nithin Kamath will represent India on the global stage at WEOY in Monte Carlo to be held in June 2025. KV Kamath, Chairman of Jio Financial Services, received the Lifetime Achievement Award for his significant contribution to India's financial services sector. S Somanath, aerospace engineer and former chairman of ISRO, received the Special Jury Award for his contribution to India's space ambitions.
- ♦ India's first AI-powered solar manufacturing line has been launched at Goldie Solar's Surat plant in Kosamba, Gujarat. It was launched by Union Minister of New and Renewable Energy Prahlad Joshi. It has a production capacity of 14 GW. 10,000 cells can be produced per hour due to AI-powered automation in high speed stringers. It has an auto EVA laying robot in the pre-lamination section. It has AI-powered 3 display EL and visual inspection system to guarantee high quality solar modules.
- NITI Aayog released a report titled Role of Women in India's Financial Development Story from Borrowers to Builders. The report is published by TransUnion CIBIL, NITI Aayog's Women Entrepreneurship Platform and Microsave Consulting. According to the report, women in India are actively seeking credit and monitoring their credit scores. Financial awareness has increased among women. By December 2024, 27 million women were seeking loans, which is 42% more than last year.
- NASA will launch the SphereX telescope to find out what happened right after the Big Bang. NASA is preparing to launch a megaphone-shaped observatory. Its purpose is to better understand what happened immediately after the Big Bang and search for the galaxy's water reserves, which are an important component for life. The SphereX space telescope was launched by the US space agency from Vandenberg Space Force Base in California on a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket.

- The Inland Waterways Authority of India has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Government of Jammu and Kashmir to develop river cruise tourism in the Union Territory. The initiative aims to promote tourism, boost employment generation, accelerate economic growth and promote waterbased leisure tourism. An international tourism event was organised under the MoU, in which Central Ports, Shipping and Waterways Minister Sarbananda Sonowal was present.
- The mining sector, which was traditionally considered a male-dominated industry, is now undergoing a transformation with the participation of women. Recognising and celebrating this change, the Ministry of Mines in collaboration with Coal India Limited organised a Women in Mines felicitation programme. The event was held ahead of the International Women's Day to recognise the contribution of women, discuss their inauguration and consider proposals to promote inclusivity.
- ♦ Delhi Railway and Information & Broadcasting Minister Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw launched several major initiatives on the occasion of the Union Jubilee of IndiaAI Mission. These firsts are aimed at strengthening research, innovation and skill development in India, thereby propelling India towards global manufacturing leadership.
- The Central Government has approved the project for construction of 12.4 km long ropeway from Govindghat to Hemkund Sahib Ji in Uttarakhand, which is a significant step under the National Ropeway Development Programme Parvatmala Pariyojana. The project offers an all-weather last-mile connectivity to major pilgrimage sites for Indian pilgrims, while also boosting tourism and local employment.
- The ambitious Cheetah Project in India is now going to be extended beyond Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh, to Banni Grasslands in Gujarat and Gandhi Sagar Sanctuary in Madhya Pradesh. The expansion was announced by Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the seventh meeting of the National Implant Board. Its primary objective is to restore the cheetah population in India and promote biodiversity conservation.
