Current Affairs Related to 13th March 2025

- A new credit appraisal model based on scoring of digital footprint of MSMEs was launched by Union Finance and Corporate Affairs Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman. In this, public sector banks will develop their internal capability to lend to the MSME sector instead of relying on external assessment. Public sector banks will develop a new credit appraisal framework based on scoring of online database of MSMEs in the economy. This credit appraisal framework will use digital and verifiable data available in the ecosystem.
- ◆ Union IT Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw introduced the IndiaAI Compute Portal. He also launched the AIKOSHA Dataset Platform to promote AI development and access. The Compute Portal provides over 18000 GPUs cloud storage and AI resources. These are for students, startups, researchers, academics and government entities. AIKOSHA aims to provide non-personal datasets, tools and mentorship to advance AI advancements. The portal will help in building India's own foundational AI models.
- Tropical Cyclone Alfred is affecting eastern Australia. Tropical Cyclone Alfred is bringing intense rainfall and unusually large waves to the region. Evacuation orders have been given in some areas. Schools have been closed and public transport has been halted. It is the first cyclone to hit eastern Australia since 1974. Alfred is forecast to come close to Brisbane, Australia's third largest city. Cyclones are unusual in colder southern waters compared to tropical northern areas.
- The Arunachal Pradesh government proposed the establishment of a family-centric citizen database. The initiative aims to ensure efficient, transparent and targeted delivery of public welfare benefits and services. With the aim of creating this database, the state government introduced the Arunachal Pradesh Arun Family Patra Authority Bill 2025 on the first day of the state budget session in the Assembly. Another bill, the Arunachal Pradesh Flood Plain Zoning Bill 2025, was also introduced in the House. It aims to regulate flood zone demarcation along the state's river waterways to reduce flood risk and ensure better land use planning.

- According to The Health Report 2025 released by Knight Frank, the number of high net worth individuals in India with assets of more than \$10 million is estimated to be 85,698 in 2024. This number is expected to increase by 9.4% to 93,753 by 2028, reflecting the country's growing wealth scenario. The number of Indian HNWIs increased by 6% year-on-year to 85,698 in 2024 from 80,686 in 2023.
- The central government has given the green signal to Project Lion. The central government has approved Project Lion with a budget of Rs 2,927.71 crore. This is an important step towards the conservation and expansion of the population of Asiatic lions. This initiative has been launched for the welfare of Asiatic lions, which number 674 as per the 2020 census. These lions are spread across 53 talukas of nine districts of Gujarat. Project Lion is an effort to integrate habitat and population management, wildlife health monitoring, human wildlife conflict mitigation, local community participation, scientific research, eco-tourism development and biodiversity conservation.
- ♦ The Cabinet approved an allocation of over Rs 10,300 crore for the India AI Mission, which is a significant step towards strengthening India's AI ecosystem. This huge financial contribution, which will run for the next five years, will promote the India AI Innovation Center, India AI Dataset Platform, India AI Application Development Initiative, and India AI FutureSkills. India's AI Mission includes major initiatives such as Future Skills, India AI Startup Financing and Safe and Reliable Artificial Intelligence.
- RBI has appointed Dr. Ajit Ratnakar Joshi as its new Executive Director. Dr Joshi will manage the Department of Statistics and Information Management as well as the Financial Stability Department of RBI. Prior to his elevation, he held the position of Principal Adviser in the Department of Statistics and Information Management. Dr Joshi brings valuable expertise with over three decades of experience in statistics, IT and cyber risk management. He has taught at the Institute for Development and Research in Banking Technology in Hyderabad.
