

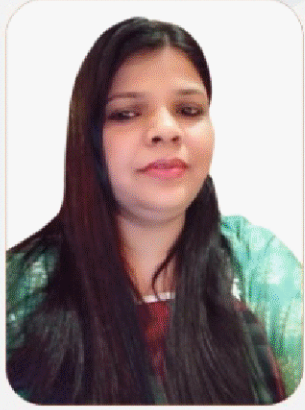

## Current Affairs Related to 15 March 2025

- ◆ **Project Hifazat was unveiled** by Punjab Social Security, Women and Child Development Minister Baljit Kaur to empower women and children facing violence. The initiative aims to improve the response mechanism and create a safe environment to report domestic violence and harassment, as well as keep the 181 helpline easily accessible. The 24x7 women and child helpline under Mission Shakti and Mission Vatsalya will be the backbone of Project Hifazat, which will provide emergency and non-emergency assistance to women and children in distress.
- ◆ **IndiGo Airlines has emerged as the world's second-fastest growing airline in terms of seat capacity**, growing 10.1% year-on-year to over 134.9 million in 2024. India's largest airline is second only to Qatar Airways, which recorded a 10.4% increase in seat capacity over the previous year, according to the latest data from the Official Airline Guide. IndiGo has been ranked as the fastest growing airline in the world in terms of flight frequency growth at an annual rate of 9.7% in 2024.
- ◆ **The US has announced a new Gold Card investment visa program for wealthy immigrants.** The new program will replace the existing EB5 visa. Immigration Gold Cards can be purchased by companies by paying \$5 million for highly talented employees. US President Donald Trump has called this initiative an upgrade from the Green Card privileges and Green Card system. EB5 provides immigration privileges to people who invest between \$800,000 and \$1.05 million. The new program is expected to start in two weeks.
- ◆ **The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade and Paytm signed an MoU.** The MoU has been signed to accelerate the growth of manufacturing and fintech and fintech startups in India and promote innovation. The partnership aims to support fintech hardware startups through mentorship and innovation guidance. This will help them develop and scale payment and financial technology solutions.
- ◆ **DPIIT and Mercedes-Benz India signed an MoU to promote manufacturing road safety and sustainability.** The partnership will focus on creating structured programs and initiatives. It will help startups by providing infrastructure, guidance, funding opportunities and market linkages. It will also facilitate international collaboration and ensure knowledge exchange to promote long-term impact.
- ◆ **India retained the Asian Women's Kabaddi Championship 2025 title by defeating Iran in the final.** India defeated Iran 32.25 in the final. The sixth edition of the Asian Women's Kabaddi Championship was held. So far India has won the title in five out of six editions. Tehran was the first city to host the Asian Women's Kabaddi Championship twice. Seven teams were divided into two groups in the Asian Women's Kabaddi Championship 2025.
- ◆ **The Assam government took an important decision and renamed Jagiroad Electronic City as Atal Tata Electronic City.** Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma made this announcement public. The move is aimed at honoring the contribution of industrialist Ratan Tata in Assam, playing an important role in the industrial and economic development of the state through the Tata Group.
- ◆ **India's economic growth is expected to grow at a rate of 6.4% in FY 2025 and FY 2026,** the latest range of S&P Global Market Sector has revealed. This estimate reflects India's steady progress despite the global economic narrative and domestic policy changes. This is close to the Reserve Bank of India's estimate of 6.6%, but slightly lower than the earlier estimate of 6.8% by S&P Global Ratings. The report said that hostel and fiscal policies, workers' interest and government spending will affect this growth.
- ◆ **Niti Aayog has said that India is ranked 5th among the world's top economies,** and its real GDP will be \$ 4.3 trillion by 2025. Niti Aayog, citing the International Monetary Fund, said that India's real GDP is on track to grow significantly.

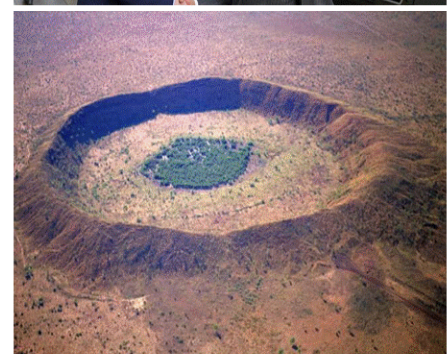
