### **Current Affairs Related to 17 March 2025**

- Parliament passed the Railway Bill 2024 for better functioning and independence of the Railway Board. The Railway Bill 2024 will amend the Railway Act 1989. Its main objective is to increase the power of the Railway Board and enhance the functioning and independence of the body. The Bill proposes to simplify the legal framework by incorporating all the provisions of the Indian Railway Board Act, 1905 and the Railways Act, 1989. The provisions of this Bill will reduce the need to refer to two laws and instead, reference to only one law will be required.
- ▶ DPIT and Mercedes-Benz India signed an MoU to promote manufacturing road safety and sustainability. The partnership will focus on creating structured programs and initiatives. It will help startups by providing infrastructure, guidance, funding opportunities and market linkages. It will also facilitate international collaboration and ensure knowledge exchange to promote long-term impact. The MoU was officially signed by Dr. Sumeet Kumar Jarangt, Director, DPIIT and Mr. Santosh Iyer, Managing Director, Mercedes Benz India.
- The Centre notified the appointment of a judge of the Calcutta High Court by the President. The Supreme Court Collegium has decided that Justice Bagchi's tenure will be more than six years. As per the seniority criteria, Justice Bagchi will take over as CJI in May 2031. Justice Bagchi was appointed a judge of the Calcutta High Court on 27 June 2011. The Supreme Court of India consists of the Chief Justice of India and not more than 33 other judges. The judges of the Supreme Court retire at the age of 65 years.
- The Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare has released the second advance estimate of production of major agricultural crops for the year 2024-2025. Kharif foodgrain production is estimated to be around 664 lakh metric tons, while Rabi foodgrain production is estimated to be over 645 lakh metric tons. Kharif rice production is estimated to increase from about 1132 LMT to over 1206 lakh metric tons in 2023-2024.

- As an important step to modernize immigration and foreigners in India, Minister of State for Home Nityanand Rai introduced the Immigration and Foreigners Mobility, 2025 in Parliament. The aim of this monument is to establish a collaborative and comprehensive tourism mechanism by eliminating the old republics of the colonial era, to strengthen national security, eliminate rules and give admission to foreign nationals. The government argues that this new university will eliminate exaggeration friends, simplify the statutory framework and establish more effective control over foreign nationals in India.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched Surat Food Security Saturation Campaign. Under this campaign, an effort has been made to identify eligible poor beneficiary families. In this, special attention will be given to Ganga Swaroopa women, elderly, Divyang and marginalized daily wage earners. The Prime Minister also distributed benefits to about 2 lakh eligible beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana. The main objective of this initiative is to ensure comprehensive food security coverage.
- The Kurdish-led and U.S.-backed Syrian Democratic Forces signed an agreement with the Damascus government to join Syria's new state institutions, which controls most of Syria's oil-rich northeast. The agreement calls for integrating SDF-controlled civilian and military institutions in northeastern Syria with the state. The agreement comes at a time when Syria is grappling with the consequences of mass killings of members of the Alawite minority in western Syria.
- India has imposed anti-dumping duty of up to US\$986 per tonne for five years on trichloro isocyanuric acid imported from China and Japan. This measure is designed to protect the domestic industry from low-cost imports. The Finance Ministry issued this decision based on the recommendations of the Directorate General of Trade Remedies. The Directorate's investigation concluded that the influx of unfairly priced imports has caused harm to the domestic market. The purpose of imposing this duty is to promote fair competition and support the domestic sector.
