

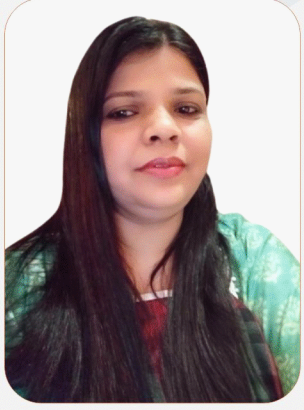

Current Affairs Related to 2nd March 2025

- ◆ **The Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation** launched a hackathon called **Innovate** with GoIStats. The theme of this hackathon will be data driven insights for developed India. The main objective of the hackathon is to inspire students and researchers to use the vast official data generated by the National Statistical Office to create innovative data driven insights. The hackathon will be held on the MyGov platform between February 25 and March 31. Students pursuing graduation, post graduation or research can participate in the event.
- ◆ **According to a report by digital rights organization Access Now**, India recorded 84 internet shutdowns in 2024, the highest among democratic countries. India is only behind Myanmar, where 85 cases of internet shutdown were recorded. This is the first time in the last six years that India has not recorded the highest number of internet shutdowns in the world.
- ◆ **The Government of India has taken immediate and decisive action to control the export** of tapentadol and carisoprodol-free unapproved combination drugs manufactured by Mumbai-based Aveo Pharmaceuticals to certain countries in West Africa. As a part of this exercise, a joint team of CDSCO and state regulatory authorities conducted a comprehensive audit of Aveo Pharmaceuticals. The findings of the audit led to the issuance of a Stop Activity Order, halting all operations at the company's premises.
- ◆ **The Reserve Bank of India launched Financial Literacy Week 2025**. The theme of Financial Literacy Week is Financial Literacy Women's Prosperity. This year's theme emphasizes on empowering women economically and socially. This campaign will create awareness about the risks and precautions while using these platforms. The campaign was launched by Abhishek Majumdar, General Manager, RBI Regional Office Itanagar.
- ◆ **Sunil Bharti Mittal, Founder and Chairman of Bharti Enterprises, received an Honorary Knighthood Medal** for advancing business relations between the United Kingdom and India. He received an honorary knighthood medal for advancing business relations between the United Kingdom and India. Mittal's leadership had a lasting impact on the UK-India partnership.
- ◆ **Hindustan Aeronautics Limited has signed an agreement with the Pune-based Institute of Advanced Technology**. Its objective is to promote research, skill development and innovation in aerospace technology. HAL Acquisition Academy, HAL's premier training institute, plays an important role in this collaboration, allowing HAL officials to receive higher education, research and training of associate aerospace technicians.
- ◆ **Datia Airport has been granted a public airport license under 3C, VFR category** by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation. Under the 3C, VFR category, regional aircraft can operate in visual flight conditions. After this permission, Datia Airport has now become the eighth public airport of Madhya Pradesh. Datia Airport has been constructed in about 184 acres. Its runway is 30 meters wide and 1810 meters long.
- ◆ **India and the United Kingdom announced that negotiations on a free trade agreement will resume**. The announcement was made by UK Department of Business and Trade Secretary Jonathan Reynolds and Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal. However, the ministers refused to give a timeline for concluding the talks and signing the FTA. Apart from the FTA, the nations are discussing a bilateral investment agreement, a totalisation agreement and a double contribution convention on social security.
- ◆ **Prime Minister Narendra Modi attended the largest ever Jhumur event in history**. Jhumoir Binandini 2025, organised to mark the 200th anniversary of Assam's tea industry, saw around 8600 dancers at the Sarusajai Stadium in Guwahati. 60 heads of missions and ambassadors from various countries also witnessed the historic event, which marked the start of the Advantage Assam 2.0 summit.
- ◆ **Manohar International Airport, developed and operated by G Mart Gate International Airport Limited, has created history**. It has become the first airport in India to be awarded the prestigious Best Safety Award in the Service Sector category under the National Safety Council Safety Awards 2024. The award was presented during a grand ceremony at The Lalit, Mumbai.

(B) To inject durable rupee liquidity into the banking system, the Reserve Bank of India will conduct a \$10 billion three-year dollar/rupee swap auction. The first leg of the transaction will be settled on March 4 and will inject about Rs 870 billion into the banking system. The RBI will need to inject at least Rs 1 trillion more into the banking system by the end of March.



2. Recently, India will train 1500 civil servants of which country in the next 5 years?

(A) Recently, the Government of India has signed an agreement with the Bangladeshi government to renew the MoU to train 1500 Bangladeshi officials and build their capacity from 2025 to 2030. The agreement was signed by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances of the Government of India and the Bangladeshi Ministry of Public Administration of the Government of Bangladesh.



3. How many gigawatts will India's wind power capacity reach by 2026-2027?

(C) India's annual wind power capacity addition is projected to more than double to an average of 7.1 gigawatts in the next two fiscal years from 3.4 gigawatts in fiscal years 2023-2025. According to a report released, this growth, driven by government measures to boost the sector, is expected to increase India's total installed wind capacity to about 63 gigawatts by 2026-2027.



4. According to a recent report, India's electricity demand is expected to grow at what percentage by 2027?

(D) Recently, the IEA said that India is also expected to register strong growth in electricity consumption. India's electricity demand is expected to grow at a rate of 6.3% annually by 2027. This is higher than the 5% growth per year during 2015 to 2024, which will be aided by growing prosperity in the world's fastest-growing emerging economy.



5. Recently, which country's first political biobank has opened in Darjeeling Zoo?

(A) India took a significant step in portfolio conservation, with the establishment of the country's first zoo-based biobank at Padyaja Naidu Himalayan Crimean Garden, located in Darjeeling, West Bengal. The facility became functional in July 2024 and aims to preserve genetic microorganisms of endangered tribals. Along with this, the biological park has also started an animal museum.

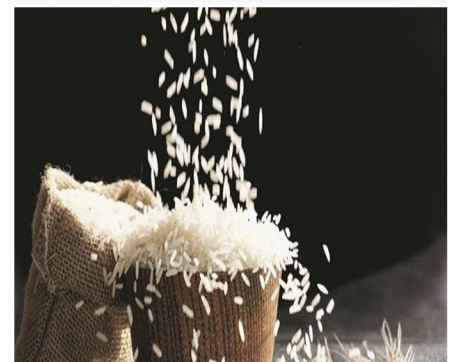
