Current Affairs Related to 22 March 2025

- India and New Zealand have started negotiating in a disciplined manner for a comprehensive and mutually agreed free trade agreement, which will give a new impetus to trade. This agreement will be the second FTA in India's Oceania region, after the India Australia Economic Cooperation and Trade Group, which was joined in April 2022. The aim of this FTA is to strengthen supply chain integration, expand market access and promote economic prosperity and enterprises for both countries.
- ♦ The Reserve Bank of India has applied for the Account Aggregator Introduction Mechanism for the self-regulatory organization. The initiative aims to eliminate fragmented financial data, remove advertising spreads and ensure consistency between different stocks. The move is expected to promote coordinated coordination, standardization and dispute resolution of AALLC.
- Mumbai Indians defeated Delhi Capitals by 8 runs in the final of the Women's Premier League at the Brabourne Cricket Stadium. For Delhi Capitals, this was their third consecutive defeat in the final of the tournament. The Women's Premier League is an annual women's Twenty20 cricket tournament in India. It is organised by the WPL Governing Council under the aegis of the Board of Control for Cricket in India.
- Parliament passed the Railway Bill 2024 for better functioning and independence of the Railway Board. The Railway Bill 2024 will amend the Railways Act 1989. Its main objective is to increase the power of the Railway Board and enhance the functioning and independence of the body. The bill proposes to simplify the legal framework by incorporating all the provisions of the Indian Railway Board Act, 1905 and the Railways Act, 1989.
- DPIT and Mercedes-Benz India signed a Memorandum of Understanding to promote manufac-

- turing road safety and sustainability. The partnership will focus on creating structured programs and initiatives. It will help startups by providing infrastructure, guidance, funding opportunities and market linkages. It will also facilitate international collaboration and ensure knowledge exchange to promote long-term impact.
- A dedicated app for the Pradhan Mantri Internship Scheme was launched by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. The app launch aims to increase participation by facilitating easy registration for the second round of the scheme, for which applications will be accepted till March 31. The app seeks to address the challenge of limited computer access by leveraging the widespread use of mobile phones, and provides user-friendly options for multiple applicants. A facilitation centre dedicated to PMIS will be set up in Kolkata along with the launch of the app.
- Amit Shah inaugurated the Lachit Borphukan Police Academy in Dergaon, Assam. According to Shah, the academy will become India's top police training institution within five years. He paid tribute to Lachit Borphukan. Lachit Borphukan is known for leading Assam's victory over the Mughals. Lachit Borphukan's biography has been translated into 23 languages. The first phase of construction of the academy was completed at a cost of Rs 167 crore. Rs 1050 crore has been allocated for all three phases. The academy aims to become the best police academy in India.
- As an important step to modernize immigration and foreigners in India, Minister of State for Home Nityanand Rai introduced the Immigration and Foreigners Mobility, 2025 in Parliament. The aim of this monument is to establish a collaborative and comprehensive tourism mechanism by eliminating the old republics of the colonial era, to strengthen national security, eliminate rules for foreign nationals and give admission.
