

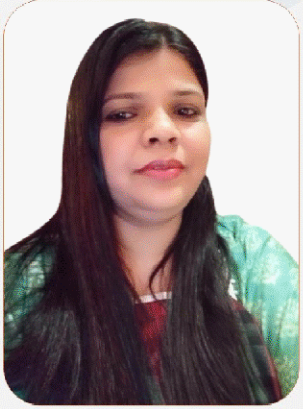

Current Affairs Related to 24 March 2025

- ◆ **Chandrayaan-5 mission comes under India's goal to land an Indian astronaut on the moon by 2040.** Chandrayaan-4 will focus on landing on the moon and collecting samples. The recently approved Chandrayaan-5 will carry a 350 kg rover.
- ◆ **The Union Ministry of Finance and Affairs launched a dedicated mobile app for Pradhan Mantri Internship Yojana in New Delhi.** The app is designed to simplify the registration and application process, provide real-time updates and provide an intuitive application to the masses. It promotes government activities to promote employment, skill development and opportunities for youth.
- ◆ **India has made its strong presence felt in the global space sector with the successful launch of 393 foreign satellites of 34 countries between 2015 and 2024.** The Indian Space Research Organisation put these satellites in orbit through launch vehicles like PSLV LVM3 and SSLV. Through this achievement, India earned foreign exchange worth US\$ 143 million, giving space to the country's space economy. This success is paving the way for ambitions like the Gaganyaan mission and the Indian space station by 2035.
- ◆ **India Masters defeated West Indies Masters by six wickets in the inaugural edition of the International Masters League 2025.** In a grand final that brought back memories of the golden era of cricket, India, led by the great Sachin Tendulkar, performed brilliantly and won the title in front of nearly 50,000 spectators at the SV Zion International Stadium. The much-awaited Plastic Waste Masters was led by Brian Lara, making it a festival of cricket legends.
- ◆ **In a significant step towards strengthening health infrastructure, the Delhi Government signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.** Under this, the Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission will be implemented. Under this scheme, 1139 Urban Ayushman Arogyas were established in Delhi, which slowed down the primary health services and provided relief from epidemics and other health problems in future.
- ◆ **Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy has launched Rajiv Yuva Vikasam Yojana.** This scheme provides self-employment loans to the youth of SC, ST, BC and minority communities. The scheme aims to create self-employment opportunities for five lakh unemployed youth in Telangana. The Telangana government has allocated six thousand crore rupees for this scheme. Financial assistance of up to Rs 3 lakh will be provided to eligible persons. With this assistance, they will be able to set up self-employment units. Selected applicants will receive loan approval documents on Telangana Foundation Day on June 2.
- ◆ **Maharashtra CM Devendra Fadnavis inaugurated the temple of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj in Bhiwandi.** The temple honors the legacy of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, and devotees can witness its glory. This is the first grand temple of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj in Maharashtra. The temple is spread over an area of 2500 square feet, with a fort-like boundary wall covering an additional 5000 square feet. The design of the temple includes typical elements of a fort, including a 42-foot hall and circular turrets.
- ◆ **India hosted the 14th meeting of the ASEAN Defence Ministers' Meeting Plus Expert Working Group on Counter-Terrorism in New Delhi.** The meeting was attended by delegations from 10 ASEAN members, including Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Vietnam, Singapore and Thailand. Apart from this, representatives from eight dialogue partners Australia, New Zealand, ROK, Japan, China, the US and Russia, as well as Timor Leste and the ASEAN Secretariat also participated in it.
- ◆ **The Indian Space Research Organisation and the Semiconductor Laboratory in Chandigarh have jointly developed 32-bit microprocessors Vikram 3201 and Kalpana 3201.** Vikram 3201 is India's first fully indigenous 32-bit microprocessor. It can be used in the harsh conditions of launch vehicles. A 32-bit microprocessor is a type of microprocessor in which the data bus, register and address bus are 32 bits wide.
- ◆ **Intel has appointed former board member and chip industry veteran Lip Boo Tan as CEO.** Tan says his main objective is to restore Intel's world-class position.

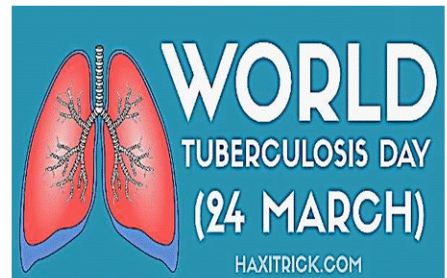
