

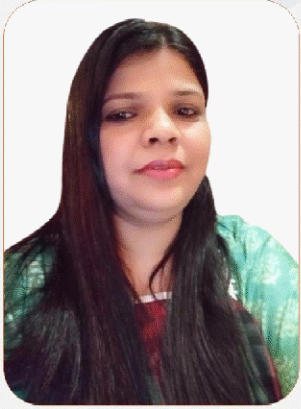

Current Affairs Related to 26th March 2025

- ◆ Former Indian cricket captain and famous batsman Krishnamachari Srikkanth has been appointed as the ambassador of Vision 2020 India event. This is being done with the aim of eliminating blindness in India. A special event was announced at Shankar Utsavalaya in Chennai, which is a major part of the Vision 2020 The Right to Sight India event.
- ◆ Famous Indian cricketer Anushka Sharma has officially worked with Skechers, a global comfort technology company. The experts included under this will now be seen in the stickers, cricket football players, business games and marketing campaigns of the brand. This is part of the strategy by Steps Stars to strengthen its hold in the cricket world. Earlier, the company had also signed Ishan Kishan and Yastika Bhatia and is also the official kit sponsor of Mumbai Indians.
- ◆ Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Sukh Ayami Singh Sukhu has released an annual budget of Rs 58,514 crore for the financial year 2025-2026. The budget focuses on promoting tourism, rural development and green energy, along with revenue deficit grants and financial schemes like plasma withdrawal. Chief Minister Sukhu assessed the financial resources of the state in his third budget speech. The revenue deficit grant has increased from Rs 10,949 crore in 2021-22 to Rs 3,257 crore in 2025-2026.
- ◆ New Zealand Prime Minister RTO Christopher Luxon made an official visit to India. The visit was accompanied by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and was his first visit to his current footprint in India. During this, he interacted with Prime Minister Modi, participated as the Chief Guest in the 10th edition of Raisina Dialogue 2025 and met President Draupadi Murmu. The objective of this visit was to strengthen trade, investment, defense, education, and multifaceted cooperation.
- ◆ India has been ranked 24th among 33 countries in a global survey conducted by the US-based think tank The Future of Free Speech. India's score in the free speech stock was 62.6, which is between South Africa and Lebanon. This survey was conducted in October 2024 and its report was published under the title 'How the World Supports Free Speech'.
- ◆ The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has launched 'Team 2025', which is aimed at providing financial support, national recognition and networking opportunities for the media and entertainment sector. This first is being organized in collaboration with the Internet and Mobile Association of India. And it will be held from 1 to 4 May 2025 at Jio World Convention Center Mumbai. TEAM 2025 is presented as part of the World Audience Visual Entertainment Summit, which will provide an opportunity to present their ideas to venture capitalists and celebrity angel critics.
- ◆ Bajaj Auto has announced the reappointment of Rajiv Bajaj as Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer once again. His new five-year term will be effective from 1 April 2025. With this leadership decision, the company has invested 1500 crores in its wholly-owned subsidiary Bajaj Auto Credit Limited. This institutional infusion has been given to strengthen the banks and ensure stability to support the asset growth of BACL for the financial year 2025-2026.
- ◆ The Telangana government has presented its biggest ever budget, crossing the 3 lakh crore mark for the first time since the formation of the state. This budget is of a total of Rs 3.04 lakh crore, in which special attention has been given to the development of economics, economic development and economists. Deputy Chief Minister and Finance Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka presented this budget in the Assembly, which emphasized on inclusiveness and equitable distribution of benefits. This financial plan has given an important list for the eligibility of agriculture, education, small class and prominent candidates.
- ◆ The much-awaited World Cup 2025 started in England which is a historic venue as for the first time this tournament was held outside Asia. The Indian men's team will start its campaign against Italy in Wolverhampton in the West Midlands region of the United Kingdom.
- ◆ Vijay Shankar, who is the Danish Honorary Consul General for South India and the head of the Sanmar Group, has been awarded the Knight's Cross of the Order of Den Brog by the Danish King.

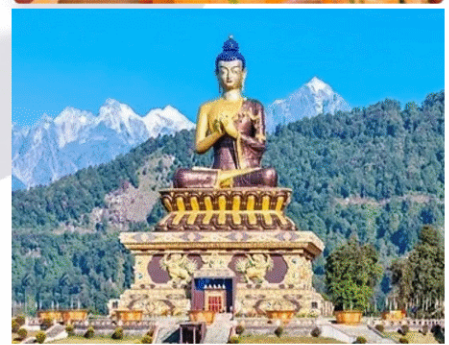

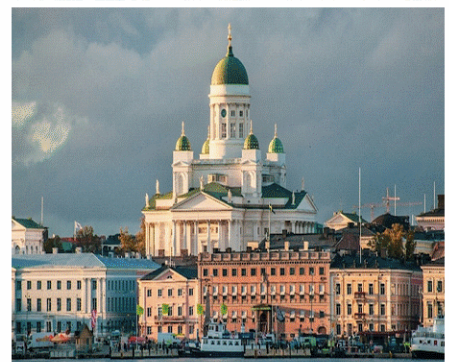
