

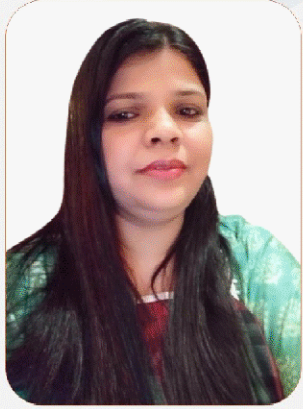

Current Affairs Related to 27th March

- ◆ The Securities and Markets Board of India has partnered with DigiLocker to provide investors easy access to their assets and reduce unclaimed assets in the Indian securities market. Under this initiative, investors can store and receive their demat stocks, franchise fund credits and consolidated account statements in DigiLocker, ensuring access to their financial data. Apart from this, SEBI has also launched a nomination facility, under which investors can appoint a legal heir, to prevent illegal transfer of their assets.
- ◆ Under the SWAYAN initiative, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology and Drone Federation of India launched the National Innovation Challenge for Drone Research. The challenge was formally inaugurated by Shri S Krishnan, Secretary, MeitY. Under SWAYAN, NIDAR aims to inspire and engage India's student and research communities to develop collaborative autonomous drones. The challenge offers a total prize pool of ₹40 lakh along with startup incubation, cloud credits, software support and internship opportunities.
- ◆ Cabinet approved an incentive scheme to promote low value BHIM UPI transactions. The government will implement the scheme at an estimated outlay of 1,500 crore. The scheme will enable small merchants to avail UPI services at no additional cost. Small merchants will be provided incentives at the rate of 0.15% per transaction value for transactions up to 2,000.
- ◆ President of India Smt. Draupadi Murmu presented the 19th Ramnath Goenka Excellence Awards in Journalism in New Delhi. The awards were given to 27 people in 13 categories, honouring journalists from print, digital and broadcast media, including investigative journalism, politics, sports and regional languages. President Murmu highlighted the contributions of Ramnath Goenka.
- ◆ India's merchandise trade deficit fell to a 42-month low of \$14.05 billion in February 2025 due to a fall in imports of gold, silver and crude oil, according to data from the Ministry of Commerce and Industry. The difference between imports and exports of goods was \$22.9 billion in January 2025.
- ◆ The government has approved the construction of a urea plant in Assam. The total cost of the plant is Rs 10,601.40 crore. It will produce 12.7 lakh tonnes of urea annually. The plant will be constructed at the Brahmaputra Valley Fertilizer Corporation Limited grounds in Namrup. The Namrup-IV fertilizer plant is expected to be completed within 48 months. The Cabinet has also approved 18% equity participation of National Fertilizers Limited. This approval is above the normal limit of the Department of Public Enterprises.
- ◆ To boost growth in the livestock sector, the Union Cabinet approved the Revised Rashtriya Gokul Mission with an additional outlay of Rs 1,000 crore for 2024-2025 and 2025-2026. Two new activities have been launched under the Revised Rashtriya Gokul Mission. The scheme will continue its core activities, which include strengthening semen stations and artificial insemination network, implementing bull production and accelerated breed improvement programmes. Milk production has increased by 63.55 per cent in the last decade after the implementation of Rashtriya Gokul Mission.
- ◆ Japan confirmed its place in the 2026 FIFA World Cup, becoming the first team to qualify after the host nation. A 2-0 win against Bahrain at Saitama Stadium gave Japan the best performance of the team entering the 48-team tournament. Daichi Kamada and Takefusa Kubo scored in the second half to ensure the team's victory, ensuring Japan made it to their eighth consecutive World Cup.
- ◆ Amit Shah inaugurated the Lachit Borphukan Police Academy in Dergaon, Assam. According to Shah, the academy will become India's top police training institution within five years. He paid tribute to Lachit Borphukan. Lachit Borphukan is known for leading Assam's victory over the Mughals. Lachit Borphukan's biography has been translated into 23 languages.
- ◆ Mumbai Indians defeated Delhi Capitals by 8 runs in the final of the Women's Premier League at the Brabourne Cricket Stadium. For Delhi Capitals, it was their third consecutive defeat in the final of the tournament. The Women's Premier League is an annual women's Twenty20 cricket tournament in India. It is organised by the WPL Governing Council under the aegis of the Board of Control for Cricket in India.
