

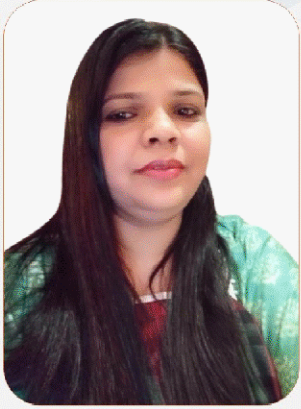

Current Affairs Related to 28th March 2025

- ◆ **The National Karmayogi Jan Seva Karyakram has been launched by the Ministry of AYUSH.** The programme aims to promote a more responsible and citizen-centric workforce. Vaidya Rajesh Kotecha, Secretary in the Ministry, launched the programme. The National Karmayogi Jan Seva Karyakram comes under the initiative of the Capacity Building Commission and emphasizes on service spirit. It motivates public servants to have a positive impact on the lives of citizens and also focuses on enhancing the skills of employees.
- ◆ **The Defence Acquisition Council, chaired by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, approved** acceptance of necessity for eight capital acquisition proposals amounting to over Rs 54,000 crore. The approval is aimed at enhancing the operational capabilities of the Indian Defence Forces. As part of celebrating 2025 as the Year of Reforms, the DAC also approved guidelines to reduce timelines at various stages of the capital acquisition process. The move aims to make the process oilier, more effective and efficient.
- ◆ **Chiranjeevi was honored in the House of Commons of the UK. He received the Lifetime Achievement Award.** He received this award for contributing to public service through cultural leadership. The UK-based organization Bridge India presented this award. Bridge India has given such an award to a person for the first time. Chiranjeevi is the founder of Chiranjeevi Eye and Blood Bank in Hyderabad. The House of Commons is the lower house of the UK Parliament. It is the democratically elected house of the UK Parliament.
- ◆ **Taking a significant step towards improving the mental health of the country's defense personnel,** the Armed Forces Medical Services and the National Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences have signed a Memorandum of Understanding for collaborative research and training. Its aim is to enhance mental health support and care for the armed forces. Director General of Armed Forces Medical Services Surgeon Vice Admiral Aarti Sareen, AVSM, VSM and Director of NIMHANS Dr. Pratima Murthy signed this MoU at a ceremony.
- ◆ **France has discovered a huge white hydrogen reserve** of 46 million tonnes in the Moselle region, which is worth \$ 92 trillion.
- ◆ **India and the European Union will hold the 4th Maritime Security Dialogue.** The 4th India-EU Maritime Security Dialogue was held in New Delhi. The Indian delegation was led by Muanpui Saiyami, Joint Secretary in the Ministry of External Affairs and the EU delegation was led by Maciej Stadzek, Director for Security and Defence Policy in the European External Action Service. The two sides agreed on ways to maintain a safe maritime environment conducive to inclusive growth and global well-being.
- ◆ **SEBI has reduced the minimum investment amount for zero coupon zero principal instruments** on the Social Stock Exchange from Rs 10,000 to Rs 1,000. Its main objective is to increase retail participation in social impact directives. This move by SEBI will promote the participation of small investors. The latest recommendation will come into effect immediately. The Social Stock Exchange is a separate segment that brings together social enterprises and donors and facilitates funding and growth of social enterprises.
- ◆ **Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh announced that India's bioeconomy has seen a 16-fold growth** in the last decade, from \$10 billion in 2014 to \$165.7 billion in 2024. The report highlights the progress made by the bioeconomy sector and the sector is contributing 4.25% to the overall gross domestic product. In the last four years, the sector has shown a CAGR of 17.9%, which reflects India's potential as a global biotechnology superpower.
- ◆ **Hydrologist Gunter Bloschl won the 2025 Stockholm Water Prize.** Bloschl's comprehensive database and analysis have revolutionized and deepened the global understanding of flood risk reduction and water resources management. All this has helped raise awareness of flood risks under climate change globally, according to the statement.
- ◆ **Veer Chotarani won the men's title at the PSA Challenger squash tournament in Chennai.** Third seed Anahat defeated top seed Akanksha Salukhe. This was Anahat's third win in four matches against Akanksha. Second seed Veer Chotarani made a strong comeback in the final.
