

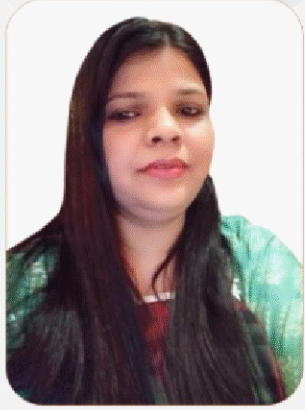

Current Affairs Related to 29th March 2025

- ◆ The administration of US President Donald Trump announced the removal of temporary legal protection of 530,000 Cubans, Haitians, Nicaraguans and Venezuelans. Immigrants from these four countries who have come to the United States from October 2022 with financial sponsors were given a two-year permit to live and work in the US. Now they will lose legal protection on April 24 or 30 days after the notice is published in the Federal Register. The move will effectively remove the two-year parole granted to these immigrants under former President Joe Biden.
- ◆ Delhi Health Minister Pankaj Kumar Singh launched six mobile dental clinics. These clinics will provide free dental care to the residents. The Delhi government and the Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences are jointly running these clinics. Each clinic has advanced dental chairs, portable X-ray machines and sterilization units. The clinics are also equipped with ultrasonic scalers for cleaning teeth. Patients will get free fluoride treatment facility.
- ◆ The UK Studios and Chartered Bodies Mission is being conducted through an integrated Odisha, which aims to explore ownership in vocational education and skill development. The main focus of the discussion was to promote industry-based skill initiatives, accommodate UK-style apprenticeships and improve multi-level training. Odisha Skill Development and Technical Education Minister Sampad Chandra Swain and British Deputy High Commissioner for East and Northeast India Andrew Fleming emphasized on deep enterprises to prepare a globally competitive skilled workforce.
- ◆ NITI University has appointed Amitabh Kant as its new Chancellor. The institution of former NITI Aayog CEO and India's G20 Sherpa Ray Kant marks a delegation leadership change, which will benefit from his extensive experience in economic reform, policy making and technology-based innovation. Kant's position as spiritual scientist K Kasturirangan's residence strengthened the progress and reputation of NU. With a special emphasis on industry dedicated education and skill development, NU aims to prepare future-ready professionals under their leadership.
- ◆ DPIIT signed an agreement with Yes Bank to strengthen India's startup ecosystem. Its main objective is to promote innovation and provide critical support to product startups, innovators and entrepreneurs across the country. The partnership will leverage DPIIT's Startup India initiative and Yes Bank's financial expertise. It will facilitate market linkages, funding, access, mentorship and infrastructure support for early-stage ventures. The startups will benefit from Yes Bank's Head Startup Program.
- ◆ Centre for Development of Telematics, an autonomous telecom research and development centre of the Department of Telecommunications, Government of India has launched the first cohort of an incubation program called SAMARTH. The program aims to promote innovation and promote technological advancement in India's telecom and IT sectors. The SAMARTH incubation program is designed to support startups and innovators developing next-generation technologies.
- ◆ Bharat Corporation Limited inaugurated its floating solar power plant at Kochi Refinery, taking an important step towards sustainable energy. The project was inaugurated by Chief Secretary Sharada Muralidharan. This is an important milestone towards the integration of earth energy resources in the operations of BPCL.
- ◆ Anuj Singh, a 2009 batch officer of the Indian Railway Electrical Engineering Service, has been appointed as Joint Secretary, Union Public Service Commission, Delhi. He is under the General Central Staffing Scheme and will hold this post for five years or till further orders. Pencil Singh is expected to play an important role in strengthening the operational institution and enterprises of UPSC through his technical and enterprise for central participation in collaboration with the Ministry of Railways.
- ◆ East Coast Railway has established a new railway zone in Indian Railways, which has become the first railway zone in India to achieve 250 million tonnes of basic freight in the financial year 2024.2025. This significant milestone was achieved 11 days ahead of schedule, making ECoR the highest freight earning Railway Zone in the country.

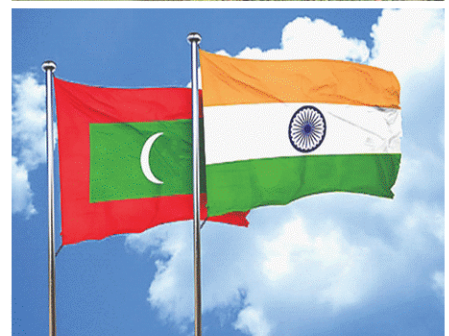
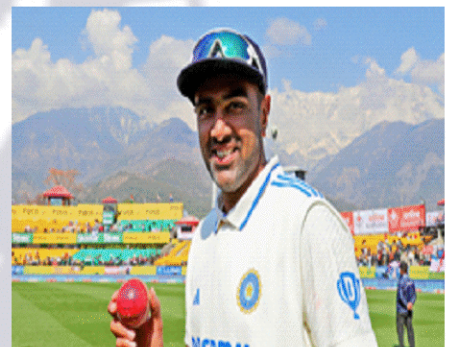
