#### Current Affairs Related to 30 March 2025

- The Central Government has announced important amendments to the investment and turnover limits in micro, small and medium enterprises. This amendment is effective from 1st April 2025 and aims to provide more financial assets and business opportunities to MSMEs. The amendment was announced by the Finance Minister during the Union Budget 2025, in which the investment limit has been increased to 2.5 times and the turnover limit has been doubled. This change will also make large businesses eligible as MSMEs, allowing them to avail loans, government incentives and other support grants.
- ♦ The Indian Institute of Record Work organized the National Championship on Samarthya: Recollect Strategy 2025 at its Manesar campus. The program provides an opportunity to students facing financial crisis to develop innovative ideational revival strategies. The aim of this competition is to promote business education, industry specialization and niche thinking, in which financial analysis, case studies and expert advisors play an important role.
- The Agricultural and Processed Food Products
  Export Development Authority, under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry has announced the
  global revival of the traditional Indian Goli Soda,
  relaunched as Goli Pop Soda. The famous beverage, once a household name, is making a remarkable comeback on the global stage with its new
  look and strategic international expansion. The
  product has already made strong inroads in global
  markets, including successful test shipments to the
  US, UK, Europe and Gulf countries
- A panel in Japan has suggested measures to prepare for a possible eruption of Mount Fuji. The report warns that a major eruption could deposit more than 10 centimetres of ash in areas such as Tokyo and Kanagawa Prefecture. The report has been released by volcanologists and disaster preparedness experts. Since Mount Fuji is densely populated, large-scale evacuations from Tokyo and surrounding areas are not possible. Residents in areas with less than 30 centimetres of ash have been advised to stay indoors.

- Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami emphasized the religious and cultural significance of the Ganga and Sharda rivers and announced plans to develop corridors along these sacred rivers to promote religious tourism in the state. These proposed river corridors aim to enhance infrastructure and provide better facilities for pilgrims visiting Uttarakhand, thereby strengthening the state's position as a major spiritual destination. The initiative is in line with the government's comprehensive vision to promote tourism while preserving the cultural and religious heritage of Uttarakhand.
- Bihar is hosting the ISTAF Sepak Takraw World Cup 2025 for the first time. The venue for the tournament is the Patliputra Sports Complex Indoor Stadium at Kankarbagh in Patna. The ISTAF Sepak Takraw World Cup 2025 is a six-day event and 20 countries, including India, are competing in it. Thailand defeated Singapore in the opening men's quad match. The Indian women's team won both matches in the quad category. Sepak Takraw, originally from Southeast Asia, is becoming famous all over the world. This is due to its inclusion in the Asian Games.
- ♦ East Coast Railway has become the first railway zone in India to achieve the target of 250 million tonnes of freight loading in the financial year 2024-2025. East Coast Railway achieved the historic feat 11 days ahead of plan. East Coast Railway has crossed the 250 million tonnes mark
  - Rashtrapati Bhavan hosted Purple Fest 2025 to promote inclusion and accessibility of persons with disabilities. It has been organized by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. 23,500 participants attended the event. It will promote an inclusive society. It saw unprecedented partnerships with Tata Power, American India Foundation Hans India, Tech Mahindra Foundation and other key stakeholders. The event featured adaptive sports such as Blind Cricket Boccia Wheelchair Basketball.
