Current Affairs Related to 6th March 2025

- Small Industries Development Bank of India and Tata Capital Limited signed MoU for partnership for financing MSMEs. The main focus of the MoU is on growth and development of MSME ecosystem by providing finance in the area of ??machinery/equipment financing, working capital/CC/OD/business loans etc. Risk sharing and joint financing will also be considered while providing credit facilities to MSMEs. SIDBI acts as the lead financial institution for promotion, financing and development of the micro, small and medium enterprises sector.
- Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology launched Aadhaar Sushasan Portal to streamline the approval process for Aadhaar authentication requests. Aadhaar Sushasan Portal allows both government and private entities to obtain Aadhaar authentication for public interest services. They can use Aadhaar authentication for public services like innovation, knowledge, sharing and improving access to essential services. This will help citizens easily access services in sectors such as healthcare, education, e-commerce and hospitality.
- India's electricity demand is projected to grow at a rate of 6.3% annually by 2027. This growth will be higher than the 5% annual growth seen between 2015 and 2024. Electricity demand in the country will grow by 6.3% per year from 2025 to 2027. Electricity demand grew by 8.3% year-on-year in 2023, and 5.8% in 2024. By 2027, India will account for 10% of the growth in global electricity demand. Solar PV generation is expected to grow by more than 28% annually from 2025 to 2027.
- RBI imposed a monetary penalty of Rs 39 lakh on Citibank. The penalty was imposed for non-compliance of certain directions related to large risk framework and submission of credit information to credit information companies. The apex bank had also imposed a penalty of Rs 620,000 on Ashirvad Micro Finance Ltd for failing to provide household income information of certain borrowers to credit information companies. It also failed to provide fact sheets to certain gold loan customers.

- To promote adventure tourism in Maharashtra, the state tourism department has planned to refit decommissioned naval warship INS Guldar and sink it near Nivati ??Rocks in Sindhudurg district. It is aimed at creating India's first artificial reef, which will promote scuba diving tourism and conserve marine biodiversity. The project is modelled on USS Spiegel Grove and pieces of Thai Royal Navy ships, where the decommissioned Florida has been reused as an artificial reef.
- Niti Aayog has said that India is ranked 5th among the world's top economies, and its real GDP will be \$4.3 trillion by 2025. Citing the International Monetary Fund, Niti Aayog said that India's real GDP is on track to grow significantly, from \$2.4 trillion in 2015 to \$4.3 trillion in 2025. India also recorded the highest inflation adjusted growth of 77% among the top 20 countries, surpassing major economies like China and the United States.
- State Bank of India has revised India's GDP growth forecast for FY2024-2025 to 6.3%, slightly lower than the National Product Office's average of 6.4%. The revision is mainly due to a slowdown in credit flow, manufacturing sector and aggregate demand. This estimate comes at a time when policymakers are focusing on maintaining growth through financial institutions and museums. SBI Research has made this revision based on the analysis of 36 high frequency applicants. According to the bank, GDP growth is expected to be between 6.2% to 6.3% in the third quarter of FY 2025.
- India is the second country in the world to launch a digital pilot license. Union Civil Aviation Minister Ram Mohan Naidu has launched India's Electronic Personnel License. The electronic personnel license will replace the traditional physical license. The electronic personnel license can be accessed through the EasyCA mobile application. The aim of this initiative is to increase security, transparency and efficiency in the process of pilot licensing.
