Current Affairs Related to 13th April

- A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed between the Union Health Ministry and the Delhi government. The objective of the MoU is to implement the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana in Delhi. Under this program, health coverage of Rs 5 lakh per family is given annually. The Delhi government will add another Rs 5 lakh to it. This will make the total Rs 10 lakh per family every year. According to Union Health Minister Jagat Prakash Nadda, more than 6,50,000 eligible families in Delhi will benefit from this program. Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana was launched in 2018.
- A new inscription related to Rajaraja Chola recently discovered atop the Somagiri hills at Melvalavu near Melur in Madurai district is being hailed by historians as an important archaeological discovery. The inscription probably dates back to around 1000 AD. The inscription begins with the honorific title Raja Mumudichola, a unique salutation found in the region known as Pandya country. The inscription mentions the reign of Rajaraja Chola in the Pandya region and describes how a military commander named Veeranarayana Pallavanarayana captured and ruled the region.
- ◆ Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited Tamil Nadu and inaugurated the new Pamban Rail Bridge. The new Pamban Rail Bridge connects Rameswaram to the mainland. It is India's first vertical lift sea bridge, marking a significant engineering feat. PM Modi also visited the Ramanathaswamy Temple in Rameswaram to offer prayers. Modi laid the foundation stone of several rail and road projects worth over Rs 8300 crore and dedicated them to the nation.
- NS Sunayna was flagged off as Indian Ocean Ship Sagar by Union Defence Minister Rajnath Singh at Karwar Naval Base in Karnataka. Sagar means Security and Growth for All in the Region. It is an initiative aimed at strengthening cooperation with countries in the Indian Ocean region. The event marked the 10th anniversary of the SAGAR initiative. It also coincides with the National Maritime Day. Rajnath Singh said that the Indian Ocean Ship SAGAR represents India's commitment to peace, prosperity and shared security in the maritime domain.

- The Haryana government has officially declared two Harappan civilization sites, Mitathal and Tighrana, located in different districts, as protected monuments and monuments. The site is about 4400 years old and has great historical and cultural importance. They offer a glimpse of the development of early agricultural societies, urban industries, craft industries and trade in the Harappan and post-Harappan periods. These places are provided statutory protection by the Haryana Heritage and Tourism Department. The move is aimed at preventing the destruction and damage of these antiquities, for which now restrictions and security arrangements will be made here.
- In a historic move, India and Sri Lanka have signed a landmark defence cooperation, the first such agreement between the two countries. It comes nearly 40 years after the Indian Peace Keeping Force was set up during the civil war. The agreement came during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's shore visit and discussions with Sri Lankan President Anu Kumara Dissanayake. It details the shared vision and multifaceted ties between the two countries in matters of security and development. The agreement is part of a broader tranche of ten key investors targeted at sectors such as defence, energy, digital cooperation and health.
 - Meta CEO Mark Zuckerberg has joined forces to launch a next-generation large language model suite called LLAMA-4 to strengthen its position in the rocket race of artificial sciences. It was announced on 6 April 2025. The suite includes three powerful models Scout, Maverick, and Behemoth with the multimodel builder and Tarak specially designed for different parts of thinking. With this prestigious move, Meta is now directly competing with leading platforms like Open Movie's Chatbox and Google's Gemini.
 - The Indian team performed brilliantly in its very first attempt at the 2025 World Boxing Cup held in Foz do Iguaçu, Brazil. Hitesh Gulia created history by winning the first gold medal for India in this competition. He was the first to win a gold medal in this prestigious tournament and became the only Indian player till date.
