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Current Affairs Related to 14th April

- The Brazilian Global Action Council has proposed to the UNFCCC, which aims to give impetus to the Global Action Council. This proposal has come before the 30th convention to be held in Belém, Brazil in November 2025. According to the decision of the Council, the design for making the pond has been prepared. - The Memorial Policy Committee of the Reserve Bank of India has announced major policy gaps in the first policy review of the new financial year. In the 54th meeting, the committee decided to reduce the 25 basis bond strength to 6%, which came into effect immediately. Along with this, the standing deposit facility rate has been increased to 5.75% and diesel standing facility and bank rate to 6.25%. The meeting was chaired by RBI Governor Shri Sanjay Agarwal, and included Dr. Nagesh Kumar, Shri Saugata Bhattacharya, Prof. Ram Singh, Dr. Rajiv Ranjan and Shri M. Rajeswara Rao.
- ♦ Bombay Stock Exchange has taken a significant step towards modernizing its technological infrastructure and preparing it for the future. BSE has appointed Viral Davda as the new Deputy Chief Information Officer. With more than 20 years of experience in technology and financial sector, it is claimed that this is in line with BSE's plan to boost its IT strategy, in line with the fast-paced financial landscape.
- ♦ Union Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh announced the completion of genome sequencing of 10000 isolates of Mycobacterium tuberculosis at a summit held in New Delhi. This achievement represents an important step in the fight against TB. This achievement also represents a major progress in India's commitment to eliminate TB before the 2030 target of the World Health Organization.
- ◆ The Indian Navy will participate in the Africa India Major Maritime Engagement Exercise with African countries. The aim of the Africa India Major Maritime Engagement is to enhance interoperability between the navies and maritime agencies of the participating countries. The first

- edition of this exercise is being hosted by the Indian Navy and the Tanzania People's Defense Force.
- The Reserve Bank of India has taken an important step towards promoting digital communication. The RBI has launched its official and certified WhatsApp channel. The aim is to provide realtime financial information across the country. This is part of the first RBI campaign, which promotes financial security, digital security and fraud prevention. Real-time information and updates will be received about financial Aadhaar, secure digital data, and fraud-related awareness.
- The Oman India Joint Investment Fund has recently appointed its new CEO, who is tasked with steering the fund's direction and development initiatives. Chavva, who has over 20 years of experience in private equity and finance, is expected to lead the fund. The Oman India Joint Investment Fund has appointed Shashi Chavva as the Chief Executive Officer. The funding is released as part of efforts to strengthen the fund's leadership and target development initiatives, it announced.
- The Supreme Court Collegium has recommended appointing Justice Arun Palli of the Punjab and Haryana High Court as the new Chief Justice of the Jammu and Kashmir and Indonesia High Court. The senior judge of the Punjab and Haryana High Court brings rich experience in law, including expertise in ecclesiastical, civil, criminal, constitutional, industrial and labour matters.
- The Childhood Poetry initiative has been launched by the government. This initiative has been started to promote Indian languages ??in early education. This initiative is in line with the National Education Policy 2020. The aim of this initiative is to create a comprehensive collection of nursery rhymes and poems in all Indian languages ????as well as English. Its aim is to provide enjoyable and relevant learning material to young learners.
- The company approved the Finance Ministry 2025 with 35 government amendments. Amajor amendment to this Waksache has abolished the 6% digital tax on likes on the online canvas. 
