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Current Affairs Related to 16th April

- The Department of Financial Services has announced the merger of 26 RRBs under the One State, One RRB initiative. This is the fourth phase of consolidation of Regional Rural Banks. The Finance Ministry launched the consolidation plan in November 2024. The merger brings together 26 RRBs from 10 states and one union territory. The goal is to improve scale, efficiency and cost effectiveness. After the merger, there will be 28 RRBs serving 700 districts. These RRBs will have more than 22000 branches. This merger will be effective from May 1.
- ◆ India's first Digital Threat Report 2024 for Banking, Financial Services and Insurance Sector was released through a collaboration between CERT-In, CSIRT-FIN and SISA. It aims to strengthen cybersecurity in financial institutions. The report provides a comprehensive overview of emerging cyber threats and strategic defense measures for the financial ecosystem. The report is designed to help BFSI organizations identify security gaps, understand emerging cyber risks and improve defense mechanisms against complex cyber attacks.
- Antar Drishti Dark Room inaugurated at NIEPVD, Dehradun and MoU signed with Amar Sewa Sangam. The facility was formally inaugurated by Shri Rajesh Agarwal, Secretary, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. Antar Drishti is a specially designed sensory experience space aimed at raising awareness and sensitizing the society towards the challenges faced by visually impaired persons.
- Plectronics Component Scheme of Rs 22919 crore notified by the Centre to promote Aatmanirbhar Bharat. This scheme with a funding of Rs 22919 crore was recently approved by the Union Cabinet to make India self-reliant in the electronics supply chain. The scheme aims to develop a strong component ecosystem by attracting large investments in the electronics component manufacturing ecosystem. It also aims to enhance domestic value addition by developing capacity and competence and integrating Indian companies with global value chains.


- Bangladesh signed Artemis Accords with NASA for non-military space exploration. Bangladesh has become the 54th country to sign the Artemis Accords with the US space agency NASA. By signing the agreement, Bangladesh will benefit through technology transfer, economic cooperation and scientific collaboration. The current capacity of the Bangladesh Space Research and Remote Sensing Organisation will be enhanced through collaboration and cooperation between ISRO and NASA.
- Union Minister Jitendra Singh launched the first Himalayan High Altitude Atmospheric and Climate Research Centre at Nathtop, Chenani in Udhampur district of Jammu and Kashmir. This landmark initiative aims to provide accurate climate and weather forecasts, as well as research and study the unique high altitude conditions of the region. Launched as a joint initiative of the Ministry of Earth Sciences, Jammu and Kashmir Forest Department and Central University of Jammu, the new centre is located at an altitude of 2250 metres above sea level.
- Agreements related to bilateral cooperation in the agriculture sector were signed by Union Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan and Israel's Agriculture Minister Avi Dichter in New Delhi. Its objective is to promote bilateral agricultural cooperation and food security and modernize agricultural practices. The agreement focuses on several key areas including soil and water management, horticulture and agricultural production, post-harvest and processing technology, agricultural mechanization animal husbandry and research and development.
- Electronics and IT Minister Ashwini Vaishnav highlighted that AI represents a new era of industrial revolution. He called upon stakeholders to contribute ideas to integrate AI in digital public infrastructure. In Delhi, Vaishnav inaugurated a oneday stakeholders meeting organized by UIDAI. Vaishnav said that Aadhaar serves as the basis for many initiatives.
- The Supreme Court has said that Tamil Nadu Governor RN Ravi has done illegal and wrongful work by reserving 10 bills re-approved by the state assembly for the President's assent. The decision came after the Tamil Nadu government challenged the governor's action.




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- 6. Recently, which country has successfully tested Gaurav from Sukhoi fighter jet?
