#### **Current Affairs Related to 21th April**

- Magaland Solar Mission was launched by Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio to accelerate the adoption of solar power systems on residential rooftops across the state. The initiative is in line with the Pradhan Mantri Surya Ghar Free Electricity Scheme and aims to make clean energy more accessible and affordable for households. The Government of India subsidy will be supplemented by the state government through additional state subsidy. Under the scheme, beneficiaries will get a subsidy of up to 96% for systems up to 2 kW and up to 85% for systems up to 3 kW, making solar power installation much more affordable for residents.
- ♦ A total of 839 projects worth Rs 5.79 lakh crore have been planned under the Sagarmala programme, out of which 272 projects worth Rs 1.41 lakh crore have been completed. Sagarmala programme is a flagship initiative of the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways. It aims to promote port-based development in the country by utilizing India's 7500 km long coastline, 14500 km navigable waterways and strategic location on major international maritime trade routes.
- Union Home Minister and Home Minister Amit Shah on his visit to Haryana unveiled the grand statue of Maharaja Agrasen, inaugurated a new friendship facility and inaugurated the recording of a religious monument. Haryana Chief Minister Chaudhary Singh Saini and other politicians were present on the occasion. Amit Shah in his research highlighted the historical heritage of Haryana, its cultural, economic and military importance.
- The Reserve Bank of India has been put under the supervision of the Reserve Bank of India on the official bench and for more financial assistance, the Bank Act 2020 has been implemented. Through this Act, RBI was given additional powers in management, stadium, stock demand and bank restoration. These amendments came into force from 26 June 2020, to ensure their financial stability and security of deposit firms. Indian women's hockey veteran Vandana Kataria announced her retirement from international hockey in 2024. With 15 years of brilliant batting, she made her mark as India's most international match-winning women's hockey player.

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated several development projects to the people of Haryana. The foundation stone of the 800 MW third unit was laid at the Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram Thermal Power Plant in Yamunanagar, which will be built at a cost of Rs 8469 crore. The project is to be completed in 52 months, with commercial operation to begin within 48 months by March 2029, increasing Haryana's domestic power generation capacity to 3382 MW. Apart from this, the foundation stone of the Gobar Dhan plant to be built at a cost of Rs 90 crore in Yamunanagar was laid.
- 4991 villages were declared Adarsh Gram under PM Ajay Yojana in 2024.2025. Pradhan Mantri SC Abhyudaya Yojana is a centrally sponsored scheme launched in 2021-2022 to improve the socio-economic conditions of SC communities. The scheme has three components Adarsh ??Gram, Grant-in-Aid for District/State Level Projects for Socio-economic Development of Scheduled Caste Communities and Hostels. In the year 2021-2022, it was subsumed under the previous Pradhan Mantri SC Abhyudaya Yojana.
- The Indian Navy and Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited have signed a project approval order under Make-1 category for the design and development of a 6 MW medium speed marine diesel engine. This prototype diesel engine will be developed at a cost of Rs 270 crore, using more than 50% indigenous content, and 70% funded by the Government of India. The contract also includes detailed design development for a 3.10 MW diesel engine. The developed engines will be used for main propulsion and power generation on ships of the Indian Navy and Indian Coast Guard.
- NITI Aayog developed the Fiscal Health Index initiative to improve understanding of the fiscal health of states in India. The FHI analysis covers eighteen major states that drive the Indian economy in terms of their contribution to India's GDP, demographics, total public expenditure, revenue and overall fiscal sustainability. Odisha topped the index.






