### Current Affairs Related to 6th April 2025

- India has taken a historic step in its clean energy transformation journey by launching an ambitious nuclear mission to strengthen its frontiers towards green energy. Announced by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and elaborated by Dr. Veteran actor Singh, the initiative aims to generate 100 GW of nuclear power by 2047. So far, the government has also disclosed 100 GW of nuclear power in the private sector under this move. The main focus of the mission will be the development of small modular reactors and indigenous nuclear technology, which will help India move rapidly towards the goal of net zero emissions by 2070.
- ♦ L&T Finance, one of India's leading non-banking financial companies, has announced Indian cricketers as its brand ambassadors. This nomination has been done with the aim of strengthening the UNESCO brand identity and connecting with a wider customer base. L&T is a reputed NBFC that provides financial products and business in urban and rural areas. The company is a leading business in rural business finance, farm equipment finance and two-wheeler finance.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi's National General Secretary approved a 2% hike in the arrears of arrears and arrears relief for central government employees and pensioners. This hike will be effective from 1st January 2025, increasing the DA from 53% to 55%. This will benefit about 48.66 lakh government employees and 66.55 lakh pensioners. This amendment has been made as per the approval of the Fourteenth Pay Commission and is aimed at reducing the disproportionate ratio.
- The Reserve Bank of India held the 8th State Statistical Cooperation Committee meeting at Gangtok. The meeting was chaired by Shri Thotgam Jang, Regional Director, RBI, while it was chaired by Shri Thotgam Jang, Regional Director, RBI. The meeting was attended by various key officials of RBI, SEBI and State Government. The main focus is to discuss the implementation of Unregulated Deposit Schemes Act, preventing digital financial fraud and promoting financial directors.
- ♦ East Coast Railway has become the first railway zone in India to achieve the target of 250 million tonnes of freight traffic in the financial year 2024-2025.

- Union Home and Registration Minister Amit Shah announced a new app-based taxi service called Sahakar, which is working on a partnership of Ola and Business, but it will be operated under a cooperative institution. It made the announcement during the discussion on the Multi-Public Cooperation Institutions, 2023 in Parliament, which also proposes to establish a national cooperative university. Sahakar Road Service has been named by the government earlier, its aim is to create parts rather than just service providers.
- Maruti Suzuki India Limited has appointed Sunil Kakkar as Additional Director and Mono Director. He has been named as Director, and his position will remain till 31 March 2028. Kakkar has more than 35 years of experience and has played a key role in corporate planning, supply chain management and local work in the company. Under his leadership, joint corporations have been established with global scientists, and he is actively involved in various industrial equipment in the Indian automobile industry.
- The Indian Banks Association, the apex body of the financial sector in India, has appointed State Bank of India Chairman Challa Srinivasulu Setty as its new President for the upcoming financial year. Setty will lead this post till the next Annual General Meeting. This was announced after the meeting of the Festival 1st Administrative Committee.
  - India has made significant progress in expanding the social security firm, as released in the International Labor Organization's World Social Security Report 2024.2026. According to this report, India's social security recruitment increased from 24.4% in 2021 to 48.8% in 2024. This achievement reflects the impact of various government applicants. Now about 92 crore people of the Ministry of Labor and Employment are availing some social security benefit in cash or kind as per the approval of the Central Government.
  - Former Australian cricketer and captain Steve Waugh has been appointed to the centre of the Australia-India Relations Advisory Board. He will work to make Australia-India relations stronger. These two boards work to make the relations between the countries better and stronger between the government, industry, education and community. Steve has been one of the great captains of Australia. Australia's Foreign Minister Penny Wong gave a statement confirming this.
