Current Affairs Related to 8th April 2025

- A total of 839 projects worth 5.79 lakh crores have been planned under the Sagarmala programme, out of which 272 projects worth 1.41 lakh crores have been completed. The Sagarmala programme is a flagship initiative of the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways. It aims to promote port-led development in the country by utilising India's 7500 km long coastline, 14500 km of navigable waterways and strategic location on major international maritime trade routes.
- ◆ PM Narendra Modi visited Thailand to attend the Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation Summit. The 6th BIMSTEC Summit was held in Bangkok, Thailand on the theme Prosperous, Resilient and Open BIMSTEC. Bilateral cooperation and future partnership between India and Thailand were the main focus of the talks between the two leaders.
- Veteran banker Ambuj Chandna, who served for over 16 years at the 16-year-old Kotak Mahindra Bank, has now joined DBS Bank India as Managing Director and Head of Consumer Group. His move comes at a time when Rajat Verma takes over as CEO of DBS Bank India on March 1, 2025. Prior to this, Chandna was on staff at Kotak Mahindra Bank as President and Head of Consumer Banking, where he played a key role in developing the bank's marketing strategy.
- ♦ Union Home Minister and Home Minister Amit Shah on his visit to Haryana unveiled a grand statue of Maharaja Agrasen, inaugurated a new friendship facility and inaugurated the dedication of a religious monument. Haryana Chief Minister Chaudhary Singh Saini and other politicians were present on the occasion. Amit Shah in his research highlighted the historical heritage of Haryana, its cultural, economic and military importance.
- UNESCO released a report titled Education and Nutrition, Learn to Eat Well. The report was published on the occasion of the Nutrition Development Summit hosted by France. The report calls on governments to not only increase access to school meals but also improve their nutritional quality. Globally, about half of primary school students received school meals in 2024, and the agency warned that the nutritional value of these meals remains a serious concern.

- The Bank Act 2020 has been implemented to give more financial support to the Reserve Bank of India on the official back. Through this act, RBI was given additional powers in management, stadium, stock demand and bank restoration. These amendments came into force from 26 June 2020, to ensure their financial stability and safety of deposit firms.
- Aid Entrepreneurship and Development Advisory Council has been formed under the leadership of Kristalina Georgieva, Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund. The objective of this council is to provide expert advice on macroeconomic and financial investors to support innovation, entrepreneurship and ideational economic development. Tata Chairman and Reserve Bank of India Board Member N.Sekaran has been appointed as a member of this Global Advisory Council.
- Indian women's hockey veteran Vandana Kataria announced her retirement from international hockey in 2024. With 15 years of brilliant batting, she made her mark as India's most international match-winning female hockey player. The 32-year-old striver shared his saints on social media and said that he loves the game while being at the peak of his career.
- The Indian Navy's two-man officer-led Seviera Sagar Memorial-II expedition entered Cape Town, South Africa, completing the fourth leg of its Global Memorial Tour. INSV Tarini was welcomed at the port by Indian Consul General Rubai Student, South African Navy Associate Admiral Lisa Hendricks and Indian Defense Advisor Captain Atul Spihia.
- Shirley Botchwey took over as the seventh General Secretary of the Commonwealth of Nations, making her the first African woman to hold the position. She replaced Patricia Scotland of Dominica, who was the first woman to be appointed to the position. Shirley Botchwey was elected to a four-year term in Apia, Samoa during the 2024 general election. Shirley Ayorkor Botchwey is a renowned politician and statesman for Ghana who has made significant contributions in the foreign affairs, national security, trade and communications sector.
