

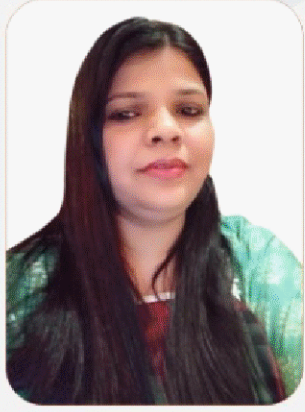

Current Affairs Related to 9th April 2025

- ◆ **4991 villages declared as Adarsh Gram under PM Aajai Yojana in 2024.2025.** Pradhan Mantri Scheduled Caste Abhyudaya Yojana is a centrally sponsored scheme launched in 2021.2022 to improve the socio-economic condition of SC communities. This scheme has three components - Adarsh ??Gram, Grant-in-Aid for District/State Level Projects for Socio-economic Development of Scheduled Caste Communities and Hostels. In the year 2021.2022, it was included under the previous Pradhan Mantri Scheduled Caste Abhyudaya Yojana.
- ◆ **The Immigration and Foreigners Bill 2025 has been taken up by the Rajya Sabha** for consideration and passage. The bill aims to modernize immigration laws in India. It gives powers to the Central Government on passport travel documents, visas and registration. Minister of State for Home Nityanand Rai introduced the bill in the Rajya Sabha. This bill has already been passed by the Lok Sabha. It creates a framework to monitor foreigners entering and leaving India in real time.
- ◆ **The Ministry of Coal said that it has achieved historic success by setting new records** in captive and commercial coal production and dispatch for the financial year 2024-2025. It has registered a significant increase of 29.79% as compared to 147.11 MT last year. There has also been an extraordinary increase in coal dispatch. It reached 190.42 MT which is 33.36% more than 142.79 MT recorded in the financial year 2023-2024.
- ◆ **In a major move to curb spam calls and cyber fraud, the Department of Telecommunications** has disconnected about 1.75 lakh direct inward dialing landline telephone numbers. These numbers were identified as being misused for unauthorized propaganda and illegal activities.
- ◆ **To boost the sale price achieved through bank e-auction, the Department of Financial Services** had redesigned its e-auction company to offer tenders from public sector offices. The company eBcare was launched on 28 February 2019. A new e-auction portal called Banknet was launched on 3 January 2025.
- ◆ **The Indian Navy and Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited** have signed a project acceptance order under the Make-1 category for the design and development of a 6 MW medium speed marine diesel engine. This prototype diesel engine will be developed at a cost of Rs 270 crore, using more than 50% indigenous content, and 70% funded by the Government of India. The contract also includes detailed design development for a 3.10 MW diesel engine. The developed engines will be used for main propulsion and power generation on ships of the Indian Navy and Indian Coast Guard.
- ◆ **NITI Aayog developed the Fiscal Health Index initiative to improve the understanding** of the fiscal health of states in India. The FHI analysis covers eighteen major states that drive the Indian economy in terms of their contribution to India's GDP, demographics, total public expenditure, revenue and overall fiscal sustainability. Odisha topped the index.
- ◆ **The second edition of Startup Maha Kumbh was inaugurated by Union Minister of Commerce and Industry Shri Piyush Goyal at Bharat Mandapam.** It aims to boost India's economic growth. Startup Maha Kumbh is a platform for entrepreneurs, investors and think tanks. More than 45 tribal enterprises are participating in it. More than 50 countries are represented in it.
- ◆ **The Telangana State Assembly adopted the Human Organ and Tissue Transplantation Act, 1994 and Rules, 1995 and the Human Organ and Tissue Transplantation Act 2011.** This Act regulates the removal, storage and transplantation of human organs and tissues for therapeutic purposes and prohibits commercial transactions. The Act also includes an advisory committee for organ donation and transplantation.
- ◆ **The Centre for Development of Telematics, an autonomous telecom research and development centre of the Department of Telecommunications, Government of India, has launched the first cohort of an incubation programme called SAMARTH.** The programme aims to foster innovation and promote technological advancement in India's telecom and IT sectors.

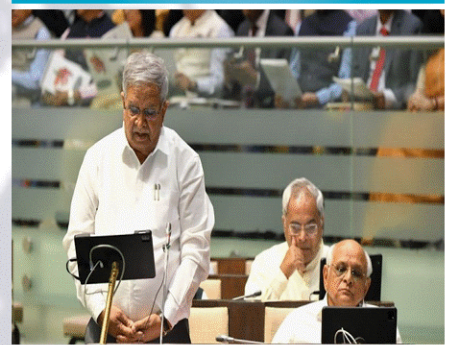
